Verification Opinion	AENOR Internacional, S.A.U. has performed the verification of the project Forest management to reduce deforestation and degradation in indigenous communities Shipibo Conibo and Cacataibo of the Ucayali region. The verification assessment covered the monitoring period from 1 July 2019 – 30 June 2020 and verified that calculated emission reductions and/or removals were achieved during the monitoring period with a reasonable level of assurance. The overall risk rating was 15 %. Therefore, the total number of credits to be deposited in the buffer account is 39,479 VCUs and the total VCUs to be issued are 223,717.
